


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Eugene Lux, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Box, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a view in perspective as viewed from the front of a display box, showing my new design; Figure 2 is a veiw in perspective thereof as viewed from the rear; and

Figure 3 is a perspective view thereof, as viewed from the front, showing the box as it appears when the cover is raised.
